

HOUSING FIRST WALES TRACKER

FEBRUARY 2018 - SEPTEMBER 2021

Housing First is an internationally proven model, which provides a settled home as quickly as possible to people with experience of entrenched homelessness and/or co-occurring complex support needs. The <u>Housing First Wales Network</u>, facilitated by Cymorth Cymru, provides a space for stakeholders to discuss best practice and support the advancement of the model in Wales. The Network has developed the <u>Housing First Wales principles</u>, based on the principles used internationally.

Over the last few years the number of Housing First projects in Wales has grown and there is a commitment in the Welsh Government's <u>Ending Homelessness Action Plan</u> to support further expansion. It therefore seemed timely to collect and publish data to show the scale and impact of Housing First across Wales.

This report includes data from February 2018, when the Welsh Government first published its Housing First guidance, to the end of September 2021. Housing First projects, identified through their engagement with the Housing First Wales Network, were contacted by Cymorth Cymru and asked to submit data for their project. They were also asked to confirm that their projects are being delivered in line with the Housing First Wales principles.

This report provides Wales-wide data, due to the small sample sizes for some projects. While these statistics have been scrutinised and we have sought clarification where the data triggered questions, the accuracy of these statistics depends primarily on the accuracy of the data collected by the Housing First projects. We should also note that where longer term clients have ceased to need regular support, the project has used their experience and expertise to surmise that they are likely to be maintaining their tenancy.






TOTAL NUMBER OF PEOPLE STARTING HOUSING TENANCIES IN WALES




PROPORTION OF HOUSING FIRST TENANCIES SUSTAINED
